#### **Case Creation Date:**

- April 9, 2025

#### **Incident Summary:**

- *It was reported that on or around March 27, 2025, Zeta Chi Epsilon and x alpha Kappa Delta Phi hosted an unregistered social event. This even was posted on social media accounts.*

#### **Student Organization Code of Conduct Violations:**

- (08) Failure to Comply
  - (C) Failure to follow all policies and procedures established by the University pertaining to student organizations, including fraternities and sororities, as outlined in the Student Organizations Handbook.
- (12) Guests
  - Student organizations are responsible for informing their guest(s) of University policies and procedures and will be held accountable for the behavior of their guest(s).
- (18) Risk Management of Events

#### **Sanctions:**

- Restriction of Social Privileges until President and Vice President of the organization meets with Ana Carrillo, Student Engagement Coordinator from Student Involvement to review the process of event registration and procedures.
  - The student organization, alpha Kappa Delta Phi Sorority is restricted from participating in key activities on campus until they complete assigned sanction. Organizational operations should be focused on the redevelopment of the organization and the completion of required sanctions.
  - Things that are not allowed during this period include (but are not limited to): sponsoring or co-sponsoring any activity that is social in nature,

including with or without alcohol; any events with other organizations; recruitment of any kind, hosting or attending philanthropic activities.

- Any questions about what is or is not allowed should be addressed to SJSU's Office of Student Conduct and Ethical Development.
- These privileges will be restored when the organization completes the sanctions.
- This sanction is Due June 2, 2025.
